Role Profile

Plan, prepare and deliver high quality classroom support identified schools. Deliver bespoke interventions in identified schools, e.g. 1:1 support, SEN, small group work. Deliver extra-curricular supervisory sessions (e.g. breakfast, break, lunchtime) and sports clubs, as required by the schools. Work with a designated coach mentor to develop the appropriate skills, knowledge and behaviours required to be a proficient Teaching Assistant. Commit to the completion of the Level 3 Teaching Assistant Standard, via the End Point Assessment.

Course Summary

Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship (equivalent to 2 A Levels A-C). Programme duration – 12-18 months. Training method – Blended learning, remote and 1-2-1 learning. English and Maths – Apprentices without level 2 English and Maths will need to achieve this level and take the test for level 2 English and maths prior to the end point assessment.

20% Off the Job

Off the job training is defined as learning which is undertaken outside of your normal day to day responsibilities and contributes towards the achievement of your apprenticeship standard.
