

Role: Functional Skills Tutor Maths and English – Alternative Provision

- Prepare and develop innovative sessions. Design and deliver group activities (indoors and outdoors) to achieve positive outcomes.
- Provide progress feedback to learners and provide support to ensure they work toward or beyond targeted outcomes
- Ensure each learner's progression and learning reviews are recorded efficiently
- Communicate any safeguarding concerns to the Designated Safeguarding Lead
